A New Women's Intensive Outpatient
Chemical Dependency Treatment Program

Pacific Crest Consortium is now offering a gender specific treatment program for women from the Clark County area. This twelve week intensive outpatient treatment group will meet three times per week on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday afternoons between 1:00 and 3:00 pm.

The program is using materials and workbooks from Stephanie Covington's *HELPING WOMEN RECOVER*. The curriculum includes sessions on:

- Chemical and physiological effects of alcohol & other drugs
- Self esteem
- Sexism, racism, and stigma
- Family of origin
- Mother myths
- Interpersonal violence
- Sexuality and addiction
- Body image
- Creating healthy relationships and support systems

Admission criteria: Adult women who meet the criteria for
ASAM Level 2.1 (intensive outpatient treatment)

Payment: Medical coupons or self pay
